Joseph Interruptions Are Invitations

Genesis 37-50

Discussion:

1. Joseph and Vision (Genesis 37:5-7, 9; 18-19)

Why do you think Joseph's brothers responded with hatred instead of curiosity?
What does this reveal about how people often react to God-given vision?
How can a God-given vision sometimes become the very reason for opposition?
What does Joseph's story teach us about the gap between vision and fulfillment?

2. Vision Gives Meaning to the Present (Proverbs 29:18; Proverbs 3:6)

What does a lack of vision look like practically in someone's life?
How does vision affect daily decisions, discipline, and direction?
How does Proverbs 3:6 connect with walking out vision? What does it look like to "acknowledge Him" while the vision is still unfolding?

3. Vision Turns Pain into Preparation (Genesis 37-50 overview)

Joseph's journey: favored son → pit → slavery → prison → palace
How does this progression reshape how we interpret setbacks?
Which season do you think would have been hardest to trust God's vision in—and why?
Which season are you personally in? Share what God is doing through it.

4. Vision Creates Focus & Discipline (Philippians 3:13-14)

What distractions most commonly pull people away from God's vision?
How does vision help us say no to good things so we can say yes to God things?

5. Vision Unites People (Acts 2:42-47)

What do you notice about the early church's shared vision?
How did it affect generosity, unity, and spiritual growth?

6. Vision Honors God (Ephesians 3:20-21)

Why is it important to remember that vision ultimately exists for God's glory, not personal recognition?
How does trusting God's vision increase faith in what He can do beyond what we ask or imagine?
How can a God-given vision be fulfilled yet still fail to honor God?
What are subtle ways personal recognition can creep into God-given vision?
How can we guard our hearts against that drift for personal recognition?
How does trusting God's vision stretch your faith beyond your comfort zone?
How does honoring God with vision change how we handle: success? failure? hidden seas?

Deeper Dive:

1. What is one area where you need to **realign your focus** with God's vision?
2. List a distraction, attitude, or fear God is asking you to release?
3. What is one practical step of obedience you can take *now*?
4. What would change in your life if you truly believed God's purpose was bigger than your platform?
5. What steps can you take to let go of resentment and anger and embrace mercy?
6. Seek God this week for clarity in His vision for your life. Write down what He shares with you.
