2. God Brings Us In (Relationship) Exodus 6

"I will take you as my people." "I will be your God."

Why do you think God wants relationship with His people, not just obedience?

Do you tend to approach God more as a Father or as a distant authority? Explain.

How does seeing God as Father change the way we approach prayer?

What are some barriers that keep believers from experiencing intimacy with God?

3. God Moves Us Forward (Purpose and Promise) Exodus 6

"I will bring you to the land." "I will give it to you."

Why do you think God gives promises before the breakthrough actually happens?

How does 1 Peter 1:3-5 encourage believers who are waiting on God's promises?

What promise or purpose from God are you currently waiting to see fulfilled?

REFLECTION:
