## Discussion:

### Personal Reflection Questions

1. What thoughts have you allowed to shape the imagination of your heart lately?
2. What have you been imagining will give you security, identity or peace?
3. Is there something in your life that has quietly become the source of your confidence instead of God?
4. Where might God be confronting an idol formed in your imagination?

### Questions About Beliefs

5. What belief about God or yourself might need to be renewed by God's truth?
6. Have you believed any lies about God's character - His goodness, His care or His power?
7. Is there an area where your imagination has been shaped more by fear than by God's promises?

### Questions About Faith

8. What promise of God do you need to allow your imagination to see again?
9. What would change in your life if you truly believed God's promises in that area?
10. Where is God inviting you to replace a false imagination with faith-filled trust?

## REFLECTION:

Have you ever believed something about God that later turned out not to be true? What changed your understanding?

What does it look like to set your mind on "things above" in everyday life (Colossians 3:2)?

What would change in your life if your thoughts, imaginations, and beliefs were fully shaped by the truth of God's Word?

In what ways can culture influence the imaginations of our hearts?
