Discussion:

Rescued for Relationship

In Exodus 6:6-7, God says He will deliver His people—but also bring them to Himself.

1. Why do you think we often focus more on what God can do rather than who He is?

Making Room for His Presence

Exodus 25:8 talks about building a sanctuary so God can dwell among them.

1. What does it look like in real life to “make room” for God?
2. What are some things that compete for that space in your life right now?

Missing the Moment

In Luke 19, Jesus weeps because people missed their moment of encounter.

1. Have you ever felt like you missed something God was doing in your life? What did that look like?
2. How is it possible to be “around the things of God” but still miss God Himself?

Deliverance vs. Deliverer “You can long for deliverance over the Deliverer.”

1. How does this show up in our prayers or expectations?
2. Which do you tend to lean toward more right now—wanting God to do something or wanting to be with Him?

Close but Not Open “Proximity is not the same as intimacy.”

1. What’s the difference between being close to God and being open to Him?
2. What might be keeping you from being fully open?

Responding to His Invitation Revelation 3:20 shows Jesus knocking.

1. What does “opening the door” actually look like in your daily life?
2. Which of these do you relate to most right now?
Distraction, Familiarity, Wrong expectations, Hardness, Self-sufficiency, Shame, Fear, Unwillingness

REFLECTION:

God is already near. The question isn't if He's speaking—it's whether we're responding.

If you know God is drawing you - don't stay where you are - respond and receive!

Is there an area where you feel Him drawing you, but you haven't responded?

Are you wanting Him—or just what He can do?

Are you close to God, but not open?

Deeper Dive:

Are you missing a moment of encounter right now?

Create a space for uninterrupted time with Him.

Intentionally invite Him into part of your life where you haven't “received” Him.
